

Right-of-way clearing projects continue

Crews remain busy in the Cookson Hills Electric service territory working on clearing the rights-of-way (ROW). The clearing of trees, limbs, foliage, and brush is an ongoing effort to decrease the number of power “blinks”, and outages as well as reduce the risk of someone coming in contact with the power lines.

Work is currently focused on finishing up the clearing of all feeders on the Porum Substation. After completing work on the Porum Substation crews will then focus on clearing all feeders on the Muldrow Substation. We anticipate this to begin sometime in June of 2023.

Members can determine which substation serves their location by looking at their most recent monthly electric bill. Look on your bill for the number and three-letter identifier located in the box labeled “Sub”. Clearing the right-of-way protects individuals from the hazards of electricity and makes power restoration quicker and safer for Cookson Hills Electric members, the public, and our personnel.
